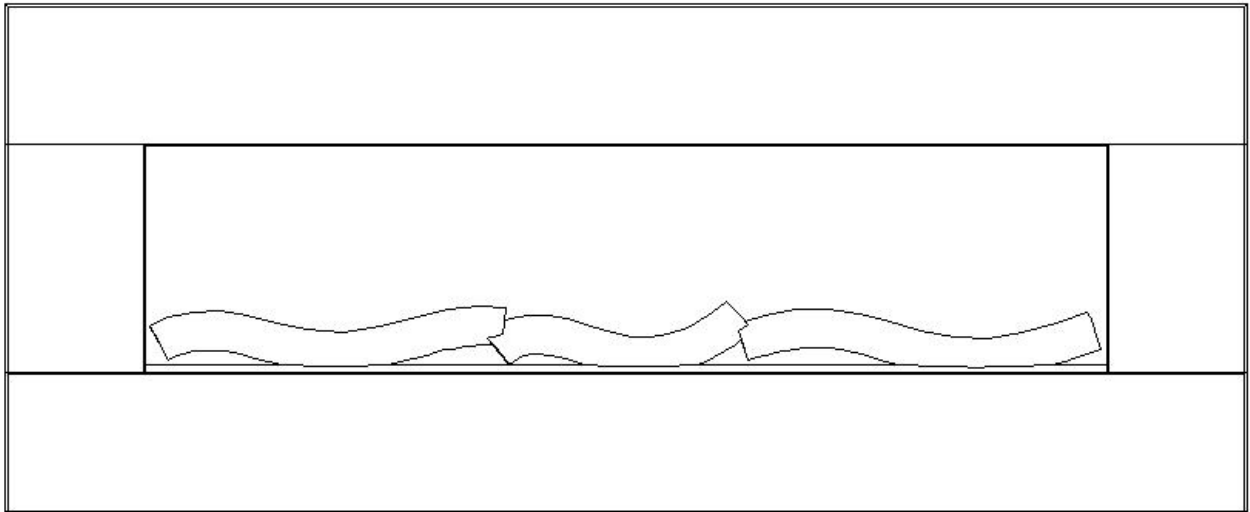

WARNING

When using electrical appliances basic precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock and injury to persons, including the following:

- Read all instructions before using this heater.
- This heater is hot when in use. To avoid burning, do not touch hot surface. If provided, use handles when moving this heater. Keep combustible materials, such as furniture, pillows, bedding, papers, clothes, and curtains at least 1 m from the front of the heater and keep them away from the sides and rear. In order to avoid overheating, do not cover the heater.
- Extreme caution is necessary when any heater is used near children or the infirm and whenever the heater is left operating and unattended.
- Always unplug heater when not in use.
- Do not operate any heater with a damaged cord or plug or after the heater malfunctions, has been dropped damaged in any manner, return heater to authorized service facility for examination, electrical or mechanical adjustment, or repair.
- Indoor use only, do not use outdoors.
- This heater is not intended for use in bathrooms, laundry areas and similar indoor locations. Never locate heater where it may fall into a bathtub or other water container.
- Do not run cord under carpeting. Do not cover cord with throw rugs, runners, or similar coverings. Arrange cord away from traffic area and where it will not be tipped over.
- To disconnect heater, turn controls to off, then remove plug from outlet.

- To prevent a possible fire, do not block air intakes or exhaust in any manner. Do not use on soft surfaces, like a bed, where openings may become blocked.












This product includes a **GLASS panel!** Always use **extreme caution** when handling **glass**. Failure to do so could result in **personal injury** or **property damage**.

Remove all parts and hardware from the carton and place them on a clean, soft, dry surface. Parts and assembly steps are grouped for free-standing or wall-hanging use. Check the parts list to make sure nothing is missing. Dispose of packaging materials properly. Please recycle whenever possible.

You will need the following tools (not included): Phillips screwdriver; stud finder; level; tape measure; electric drill; 1/4" wood drill bit, hammer.

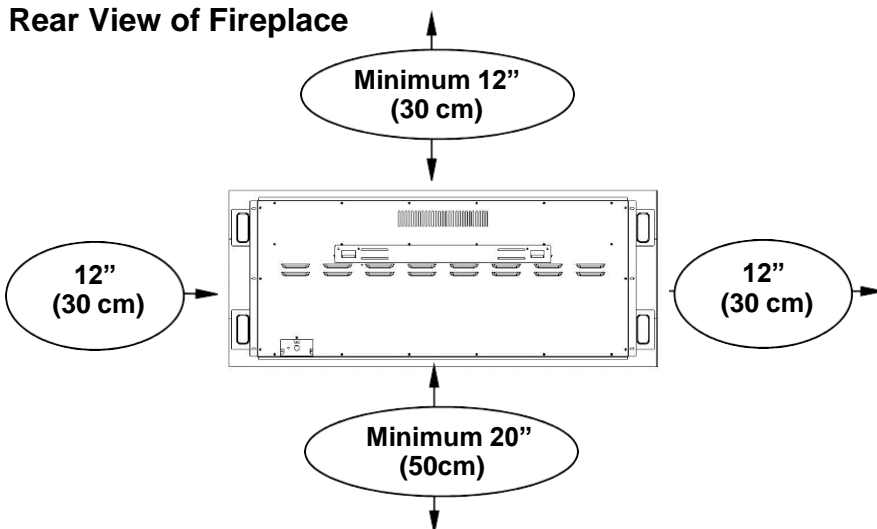

Installation and Assembly

Wall Mounted Installation

Rear View of Fireplace



Step 1. Find a safe location.

Minimum clearance on each side:
12" (30 cm).

Minimum clearance below: 20" (50 cm).

Minimum clearance above: 12" (30 cm).

Minimum clearance from the front : 3 feet (90 cm).

Choose a location near an outlet so an extension cord is not required.

DO NOT position the unit **directly below** a power outlet.

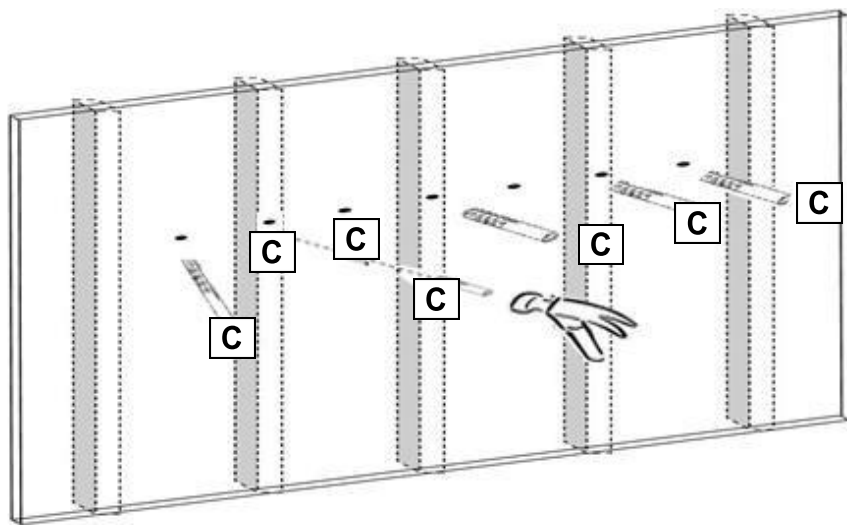
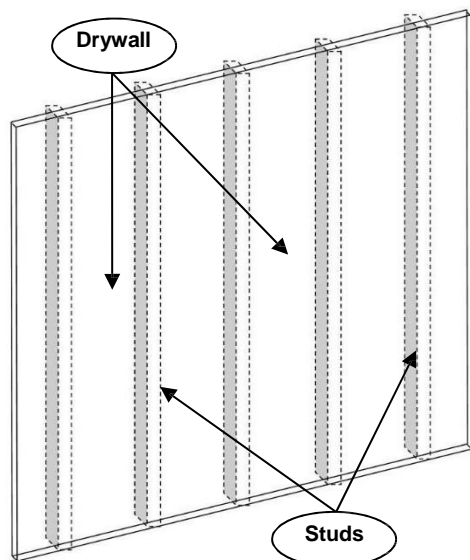

NOTICE

The wall mount fasteners included with this fireplace are for use **ONLY** with a wood-framed wall covered in drywall (sheet rock). For concrete walls, cinder blocks, or other wall types, consult a professional for the best attachment methods.



ALWAYS unplug this fireplace heater **before assembly or cleaning, or before relocating.** Failure to do so could result in **electric shock, fire, or personal injury.**



STEP 2. A. Locate the wall studs using an electronic stud-finder. Mark the hole locations with a pencil. The holes should be 8" (20.3 cm) apart, and level. The minimum height from the surface below must be 6" (30 cm). **B.** Three screws should be screwed directly into wall studs. Then, four drywall anchors are needed.



AVOID INJURY and DAMAGE! Three screws should be screwed directly into wall studs and additional screws must also be screwed into the drywall anchors.

Due to the many different materials used on different walls, it is highly recommended that you consult your local builder before you install this appliance on the wall.

A. Select a location that is not prone to moisture and is located at least 36" (914mm) away from combustible materials such as curtain drapes, furniture, bedding, paper, etc.

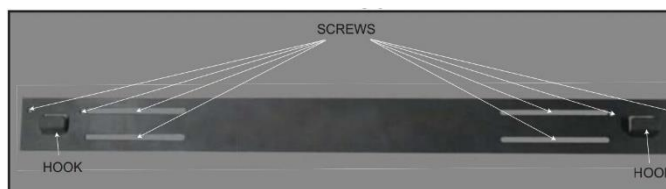
B. Have two people hold the appliance against the wall to determine the final location.

C. Place unit face down on a soft, non-abrasive surface. Remove the bracket from the back of the unit by removing the screws, refer to Figure 1.

D. Mark out location, then mount the bracket(s) onto the wall using the supplied screws. This bracket **MUST** have the hooks facing upward and be level.

NOTE: It is strongly recommended that the mounting bracket be Screwed into the wall studs

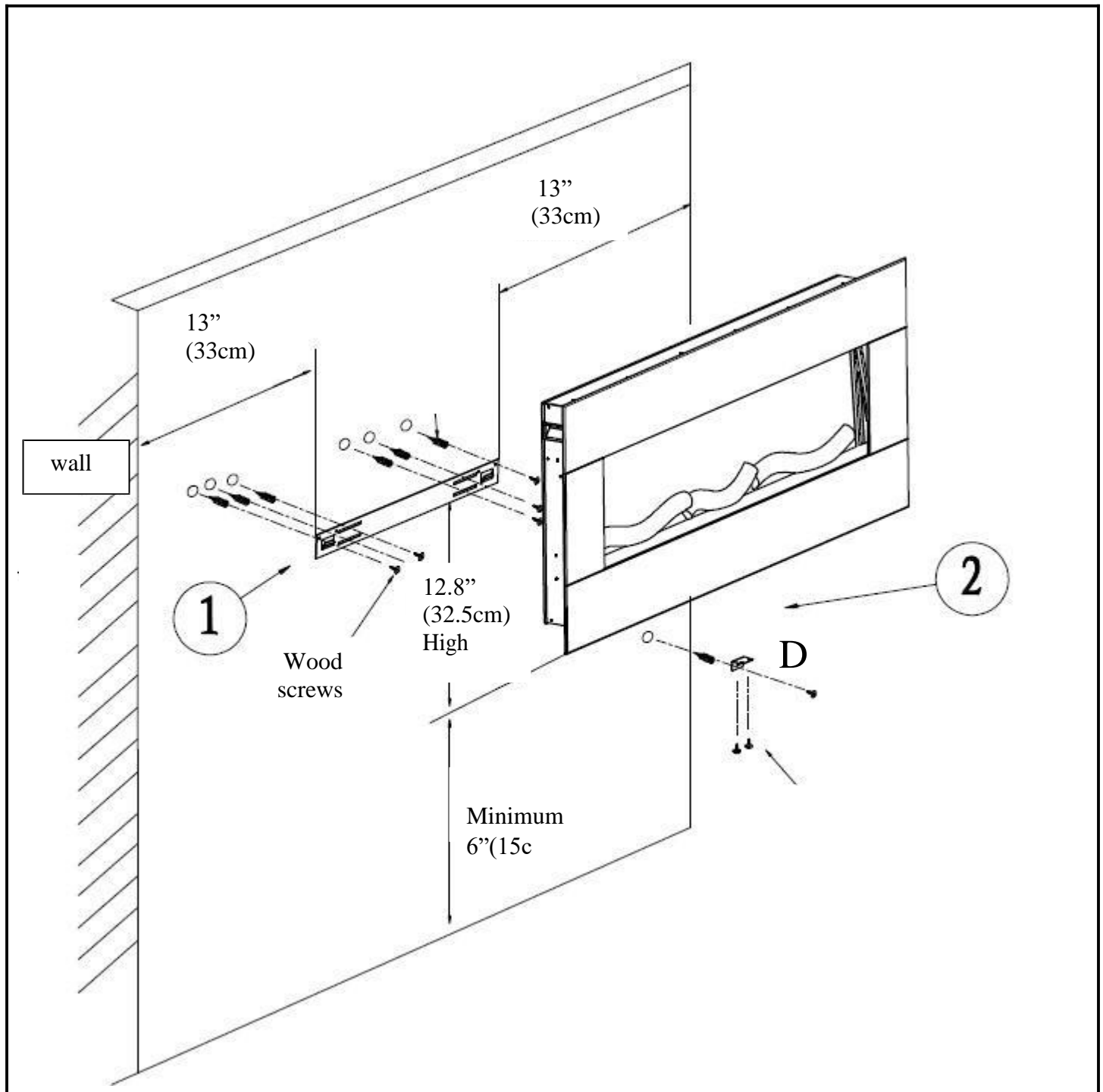
Where possible. If the wall Studs cannot be used, ensure



That the supplied plastic anchors are used to affix the bracket to the wall and the bracket is adequately secured.

E. With the wall mounting bracket installed have two people lift the appliance up and insert the two hooks on the bracket into the two slots on the back of the appliance.

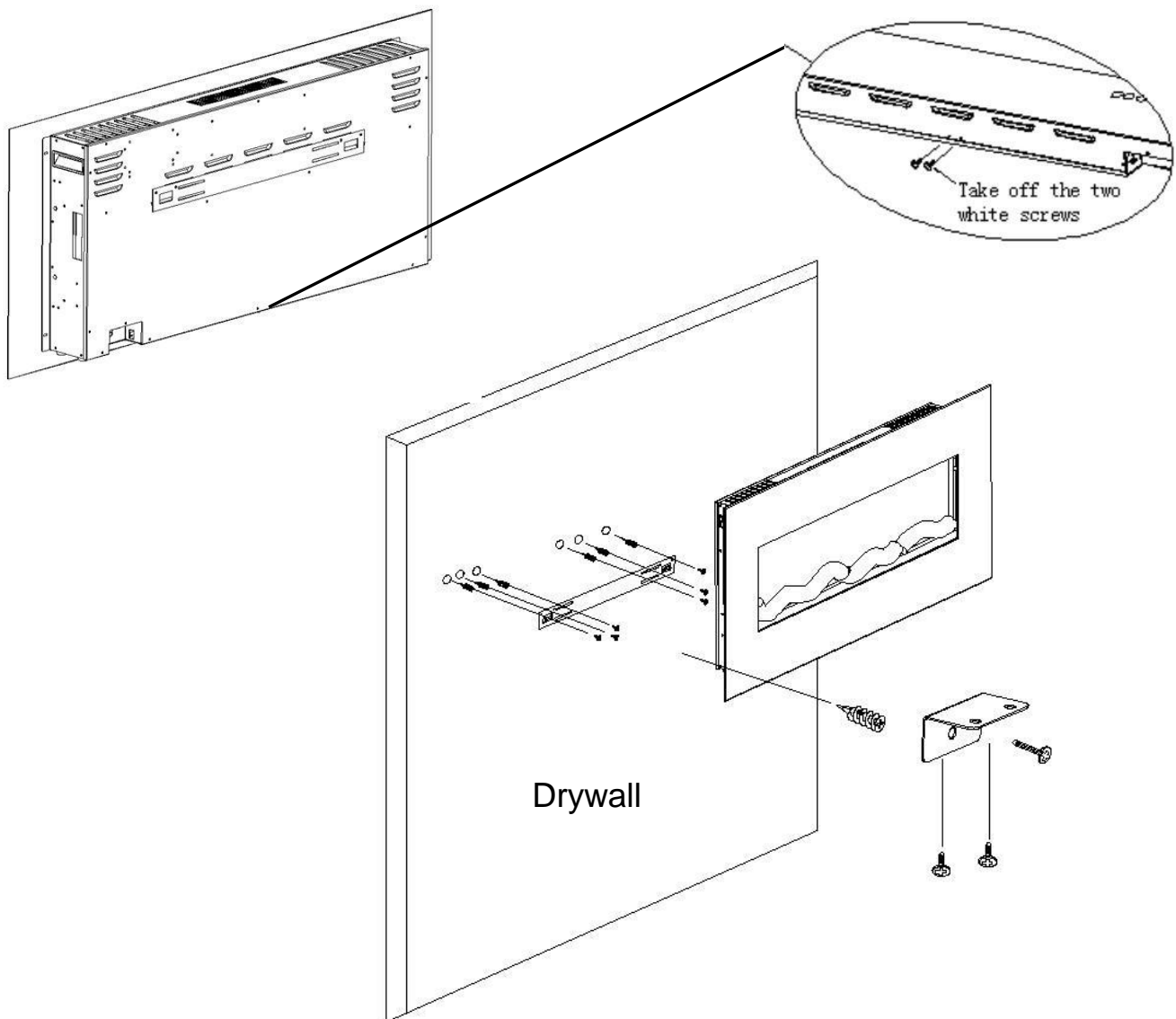
F. Check the appliance for stability ensuring that the bracket will not pull free from the wall.



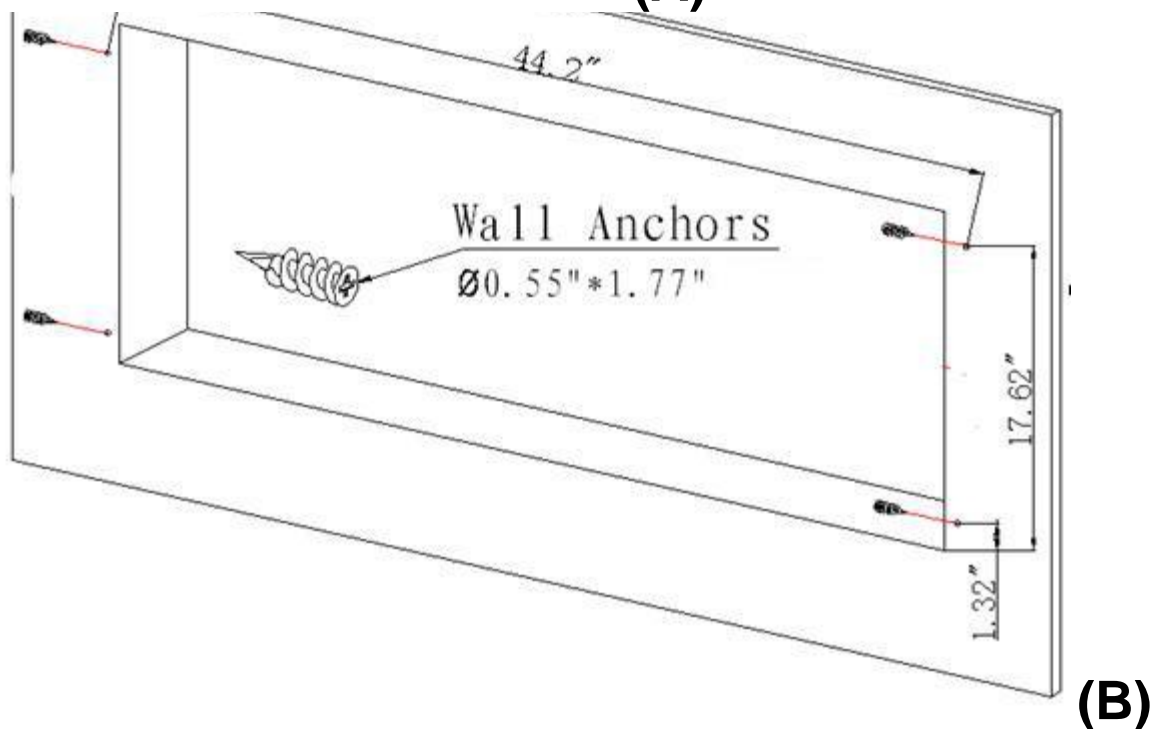
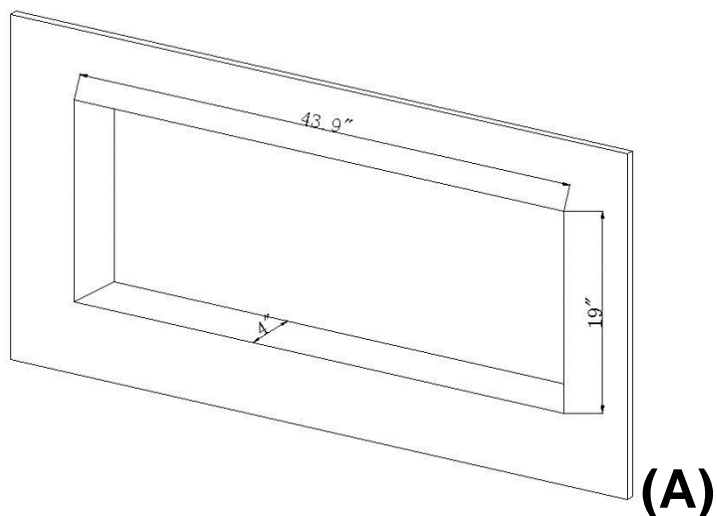
“L” Shape Mounting Bracket Installation

A. After finishing the installation of the wall bracket, you need to use the small “L” shape mounting bracket **(D)** to attach the fireplace box to the wall.

B. Remove the two white screws on the bottom of the fireplace box, then grab the ‘L’ shape mounting bracket. Attach one side of the bracket to the bottom of fireplace with the two white screws, attach the other side to the wall with one **Drywall anchors (C)** & **Wood screw (B)** to lock them tightly. **As below figure**



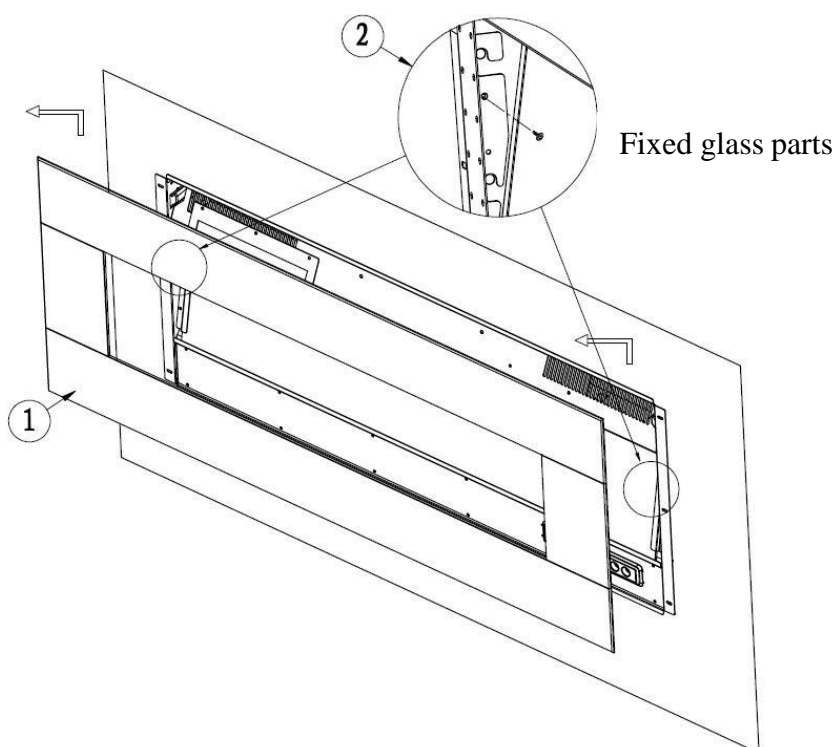
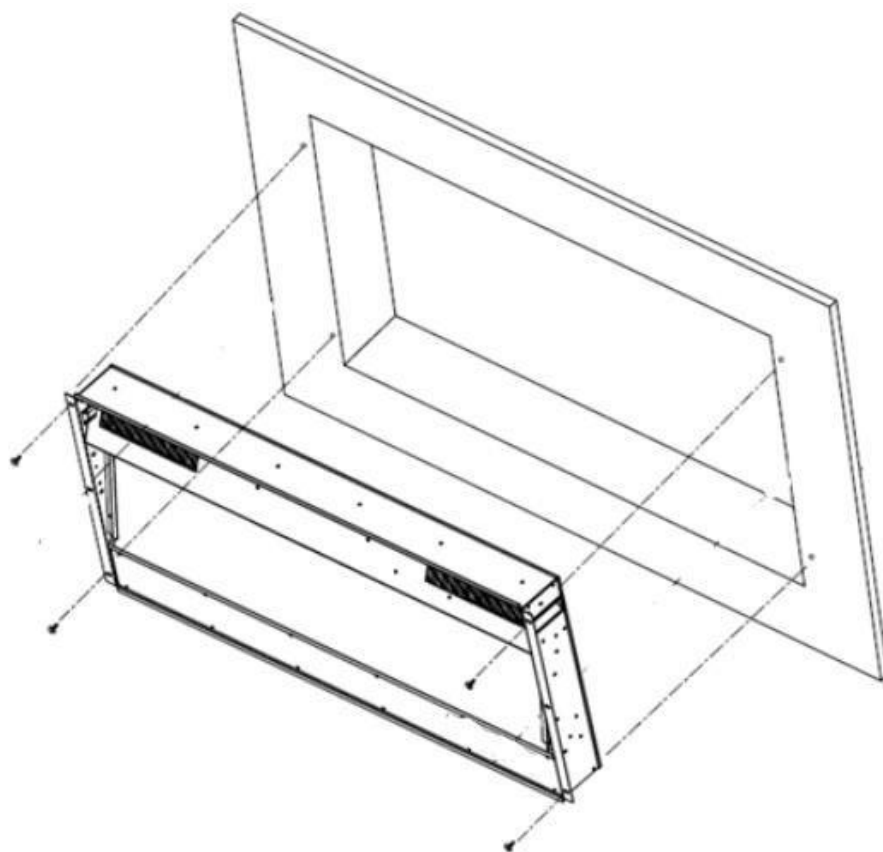
RECESSED TO WALL INSTALLATION



STEP A. Select a dry wall to open a hole for fireplace box. Size of hole as below chart Figure (A)

STEP B. Fix the four wall anchors in each side of the fireplace box according to the dimensions shown on the drawing. Figure (B)



Log-set / Pebbles Ember Installation

(NOTE: Please make the installation according to the embers which you bought or selected.)

- A. Glass front must be removed and the appliance mounted in its final location before the log-set / pebble embers are installed.
- B. If you want your fireplace with a log-set, remove the log-set from the package and put it to the designed slot in the fireplace as below. **Figure 1.**
- C. If you want your fireplace with Pebbles, they may need cleaned. The pebbles may have a fine oil residue that needs to be cleaned prior to installation. Clean them with mild dish soap, drain, rinse thoroughly and dry before placing into the tray.
- D. Place the Media tray holder (**H**) to the fireplace designed place. Then, carefully place pebble embers (**G**) into the bottom tray on the front of the appliance as illustrated. Apply an even layer from side to side. **Figure 2, Figure 3.**

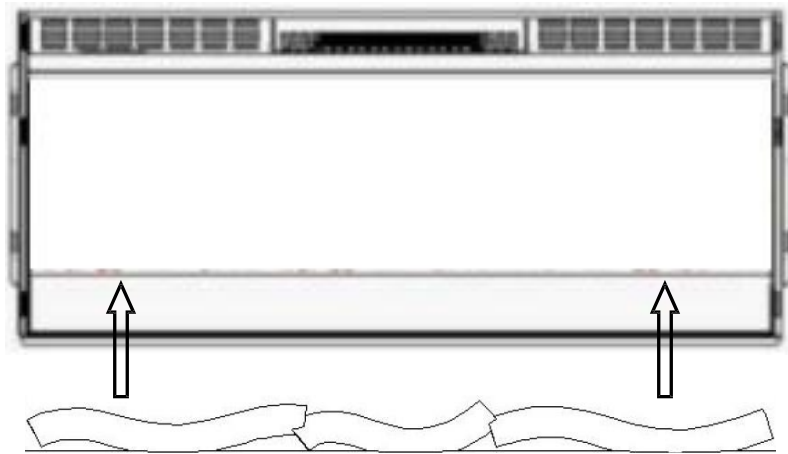

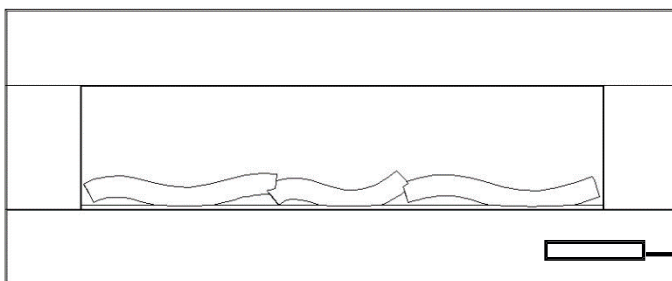
Top View



Before you start


- The product must be installed/facing upright when the timer is being set.
- The product must be turned ON when calibrating the product and setting the timer function.
- The remote must be pointed at the product at all times during the setting of the timer function.
- The product runs off the time shown on the remote, it does not rely on any other timer capability.

TIMER SETTINGS ON REMOTE CONTROL

 : Timer: Displays current day, time, and week. Press to enter or confirm timer settings.	
 : Settings: Press to move to next step (use with Timer button). Press to confirm week timer.	
 : Back: Press to clear timer settings. Press to return to the previous step (use with Settings button).

TEMP

TEMPERATURE button: Turns heater on and off.

1 Set current day and time

- Press  once. When "MON" (Monday) begins flashing, use  to select the current day.
- Press  . When the hour digits begin flashing, use  to select the current hour.
- Press  again. When the minute digits begin flashing, use  to select the current minute.
- Press  again. The current time is now set.

NOTE:

- The timer must be calibrated on the controller prior to starting to set the timer function.

- Once the time is calibrated you will hear a beep from the product, to confirm the function has been received.

2 Set ON/OFF time and temperature on a weekly cycle

1. Press . When "MON" begins flashing, press 3 times. When "ON" begins flashing, use to select the desired hour and minute to turn on the heater. Press at any time to clear the digits and shut down "ON" timer.

NOTE:

- For the timer function to activate, the product must be turned OFF via the remote, the heater function will not start with the product remaining ON.

note:

The timer can only be adjusted in 30-minute increments (i.e. 00:00 - 00:30; 00:30 - 01:00, etc.)

2. Press . When "OFF" begins flashing, use to select the desired hour and minute to turn off the heater. Press at any time to clear the digits and shut down "OFF" timer.
3. Press again. When "18" begins flashing, use to select the desired temperature for Monday.

note:

If the temperature was previously set, those digits will be shown instead of "18".

4. Press again. When "TUES" appears on the screen and "ON" begins flashing, use to select the desired hour and minute to turn on the heater for Tuesday.
5. Press again. When "OFF" begins flashing, use to select the desired hour and minute to turn off the heater for Tuesday.
6. Press again. When "18" begins flashing, use to select the desired temperature for Tuesday.
7. Repeat steps 1 to 6 to set the "ON/OFF" time and temperature for Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
8. Press or to complete programming, ensuring to aim the remote control at the receiver, located in the middle of the appliance. The appliance will "beep" once to confirm that programming has been successful.

Open window warning

If the room temperature decreases by 10 degrees within 3 minutes, the appliance will assume there is an open window nearby. In order to conserve energy, the heater will automatically switch from High Heat to Low Heat, or if the heater is already at Low Heat, it will turn off completely.

When switching from High Heat to Low Heat, the appliance will beep 3 times and the digital display will flash "88" 3 times before displaying the existing heating status.

When switching from Low Heat to Off, the appliance will beep 3 times and the digital display will flash "88" continuously.

To reset the heating function, see "operating remote control" section.

NOTICE

When the heater is first turned on, a slight odor may be present. This is normal and should not occur again unless the heater is not used for a long period of time.

NOTICE

To improve operation, **aim** the remote control at the front of the fireplace. **DO NOT press the buttons too quickly.** Give the unit time to respond to each command.

Remote Control Battery Information

- This remote control uses **TWO AAA batteries (Not included).**



NEVER dispose of batteries in **fire**. Failure to observe this precaution **may result in an explosion**. Dispose of batteries at your local hazardous material processing center.

Temperature Limiting Control

This heater is equipped with a Temperature Limiting Control. Should the heater reach an unsafe temperature, the heater will automatically turn OFF. To reset:

- Unplug the power cord from the outlet.
- Turn the power switch on the touch display PANEL to off, **Wait 5 minutes.**
- Inspect the fireplace to make sure no vents are blocked, or clogged with dust or lint. If they are, use a vacuum to clean the vent areas.
- With the POWER switch in the OFF position, plug the power cord back into the outlet.
- If the problem continues, have your outlet and wiring inspected by a professional.

Care and Maintenance

Cleaning



ALWAYS turn the heater **OFF** and **unplug the power cord from the outlet** before cleaning, performing maintenance, or moving this fireplace. Failure to do so could result in **electric shock, fire, or personal injury**.



NEVER immerse in water or **spray with water**. Doing so could result in **electric shock, fire, or personal injury**.

Metal:

- Buff using a soft cloth, slightly dampened with a citrus oil-based product.
- DO NOT** use brass polish or household cleaners as these products will damage the metal trim.

Glass:

- Use a good quality glass cleaner sprayed onto the cloth or towel. Dry thoroughly with a paper towel or lint-free cloth.
- NEVER** use abrasive cleansers, liquid sprays, or any cleaner that could scratch the surface.

Vents:

- Use a vacuum or duster to remove dust and dirt from the heater and vent areas.

Plastic:

- Wipe gently with a slightly damp cloth and a mild solution of dish soap and warm water.
- NEVER** use abrasive cleansers, liquid sprays, or any cleaner that could scratch the surface.

Maintenance



Risk of electric shock! DO NOT OPEN any panels other than the bulb replacement plate! No user-serviceable parts inside!



ALWAYS turn the heater **OFF** and **unplug the power cord from the outlet** before cleaning, performing maintenance, or moving this fireplace. Failure to do so could result in **electric shock, fire, or personal injury**.

Electrical and Moving Parts:

- The fan motors are lubricated at the factory and will not require lubrication.
- Electrical components are integrated in the fireplace and are not serviceable by the consumer.

Storage: Store heater in a clean dry place when not in use.



WARNING! Other than replacing the light bulb, **NO SERVICING** of the internal or electrical parts should be performed by the consumer. Do not service the unit yourself.



WEEE:
